### **MEMORANDUM OPINION**

This is an appeal from a judgment signed July 26, 2000. No clerk's record has been filed. The clerk responsible for preparing the record in this appeal informed the court appellant did not make arrangements to pay for the record.

On January 3, 2001, notification was transmitted to all parties of the Court's intent to dismiss the appeal for want of prosecution unless, within fifteen days, appellant paid or made arrangements to pay for the record and provided this court with proof of payment. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 37.3(b).

Appellant's response demonstrates no reasonable explanation for failure to timely pay for the record.

Accordingly, the appeal is ordered dismissed.
