ORDER

Be it remembered that on this day came to be considered Defendants' Motion to Declare Plaintiff Vexatious. After considering the pleadings of the parties filed herein and the argument of counsel, the Court is of the opinion that the motion is meritorious and that the following order should issue:

It is hereby ordered that said motion is **GRANTED**. Plaintiff Wayne Ernest Barker, TDCJ No. 900987, is hereby determined to be a vexatious litigant.

Plaintiff is ordered to furnish security in the amount of \$2000.00. This amount must be furnished to the Court on or before the date of 1 June, 2010. Should Plaintiff fail to furnish such security within the time set by this Order, the above referenced and numbered cause is dismissed. Should the case be dismissed upon its merits, Plaintiff shall pay Defendant's reasonable expenses incurred in or in connection with this litigation, including costs and attorney's fees.

It is further ordered that the Clerk of the Court shall refuse the filing of any litigation presented by Wayne Ernest Barker, TDCJ No. 900987, unless Barker first obtains an order from the local administrative judge permitting the filing.

It is further ordered that the Clerk of the Court shall forward a copy of this Order to the Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial System in accordance with Section 11.104(a) of the Texas Civil Practice & Remedies Code for Plaintiff to be added to the List of Vexatious Litigants.
