

IT IS SO ORDERED.



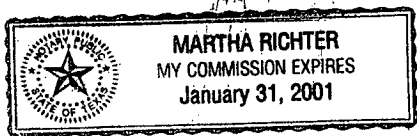
**II.**

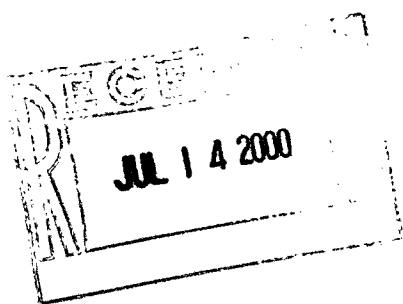
