4. MACK AND BARNES COMPLAINT

4.1 A. ADJUA A. UMOJA ENGAGED IN CONDUCT VIOLATING TEXAS DISCIPLINARY RULES OF PROFESSIONAL CONDUCT:

1.01 (b)(1) neglecting a legal matter entrusted to the lawyer, and

1.01 (b)(2) failing to carry out completely the obligations owed to a client.
