The State Commission on Judicial Conduct has recommended that the Honorable Armando Garza, Municipal Court Judge, Edcouch, Hidalgo County, Texas, Respondent, be suspended without pay pursuant to Article 5, § 1-a(6)A, Texas Constitution, and Rule 15 (b) of the Procedural rules for the Removal or Retirement of Judges, pending final disposition by the Commission of the charge against Respondent.

Having considered the Commission's Request, it is the Order of the Supreme Court of Texas that the Honorable Armando Garcia, Municipal Court Judge, Edcough, Hidalgo County, Texas, shall be suspended from office without pay effective July 1, 2003, pursuant to Article 5, § 1-a(6)A, Texas Constitution, pending final disposition by the Commission of the charge against Respondent, unless Respondent presents to the Commission and this Court before that date evidence that he has completed the twelve (12) required hours of education in which he is presently deficient.
