Dear Mr. Weber:

The Court, on its own motion, is requesting that the Supreme Court transfer the above-referenced case to another court of appeals. During our preparation of this appeal, we determined that the First Court of Appeals, as well as Chief Justice Radack, Justice Nuchia, and our Clerk, Margie Thompson, were all named as defendants in the trial court below. None of the parties from this Court were ever served in the case, which was ultimately dismissed. Rather than review the dismissal of a case in which we are named defendants, we would request that the Supreme Court transfer the case to another court of appeals.

The status of the appeal is that the record and appellant's brief have been filed and the case has been "at issue" since October 5, 2004.

We have abated the appeal pending the supreme court's decision, and we will follow whatever order the Texas Supreme Court issues in this case.


