## ORDER AMENDING POLICIES AND PROCEDURES GOVERNING THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE BASIC CIVIL LEGAL SERVICES PROGRAM

**ORDERED** that:

Rule 12, Rules and Procedures Governing the Administration of the Basic Civil Legal Services Program, approved by *Order of the Supreme Court of Texas*, Misc. Docket No. 98-9001, dated January 7, 1998, is amended as follows:

### **12. Administrative Costs to the Foundation**


The Foundation may expend funds for administrative costs of the Basic Civil Legal Services Program and shall be reimbursed periodically upon application to the Court from the judicial fund ~~in the amount of 3.5% of the funds deposited to the Account.~~ The amount of reimbursement shall be 3.5% of the funds deposited in the Account, less \$12,500, which will be maintained by the Court to offset its administrative costs.


Paragraph 1 of the *Order of the Supreme Court of Texas*, Misc. Docket No. 98-9061 (concerning Policies on Administration of Basic Civil Legal Services Program), dated April 27, 1998, is amended as follows:


1. The ~~3.5%~~ reimbursement to the Texas Equal Access to Justice Foundation (hereafter "Foundation") provided by Rule 12 of the rules adopted by the court on January 7, 1998 (Misc. Docket No. 98-9001) is a service fee and not a reimbursement of actual expenses. The Foundation will invoice the Court for ~~3.5% of funds received by the program~~ the appropriate reimbursement.


These amendments are effective September 1, 2005.


