
ORDERED that:







LOCAL RULE FOR LUBBOCK COUNTY


All final orders in which child or medical support is initially ordered to be paid by a party shall be deemed to include an application for Title IV-D child support services provided by the County and the Office of the Attorney General of Texas, pursuant to Chapter 231 of the Texas Family Code.

Unless required to accept Title IV-D child support services pursuant to other laws, a child support obligee entitled to receive services pursuant to this rule may decline services by filing a written Refusal of IV-D Child Support Services with the Office of the Attorney General. Refusal of Title IV-D child support services pursuant to this rule does not preclude a subsequent written application for services.
