At the February 1991 meeting of the judges of the civil trial division, the following amendments to the local rules of that division were approved:

Rule 2 - change "on a weekly basis" to "on a monthly basis."

Rule 3.1.1: Add "or 3.5" to the end of the second sentence.

Rule 3.5.2: The first sentence is changed to read as follows:
"The Ancillary Judge is responsible for hearing all matters on the ancillary docket, including temporary injunction hearings following the granting of a temporary restraining order by an earlier ancillary judge."

Rule 3.5.4(1): change "temporary restraining order" to "temporary injunction."

Rule 3.5.4(2): delete


