II.



Movant's State Bar Card number is 10832000. Movant's current address is [REDACTED].

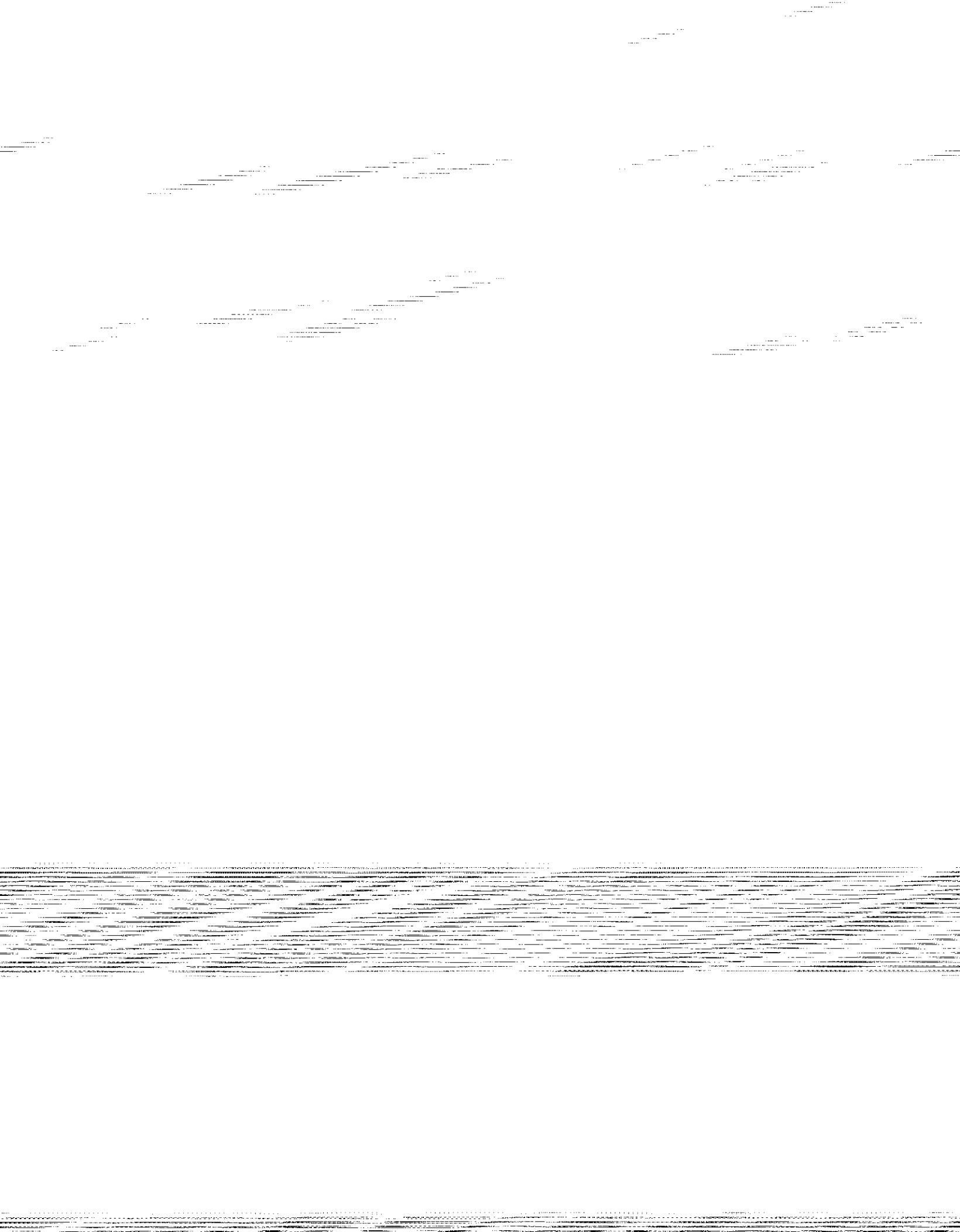
Movant prays that the Court accept his resignation as Attorney and Counselor at Law and drop his name from the list of persons licensed to practice law in the State of Texas.


V.
