



final decree purported to release the lien placed on the rent house and also lowered the property settlement figure as set forth in the original decree.

The amended final decree had never been approved or signed by Judge Olsen. Movant knew that the amended decree was a falsity and, in fact, signed Judge Olsen's name to the decree without her knowledge or consent.

Movant attaches hereto and hereby surrenders his license which was issued by the Court on September 24, 1973. Movant will surrender his permanent State Bar Card on October 2, 1992.



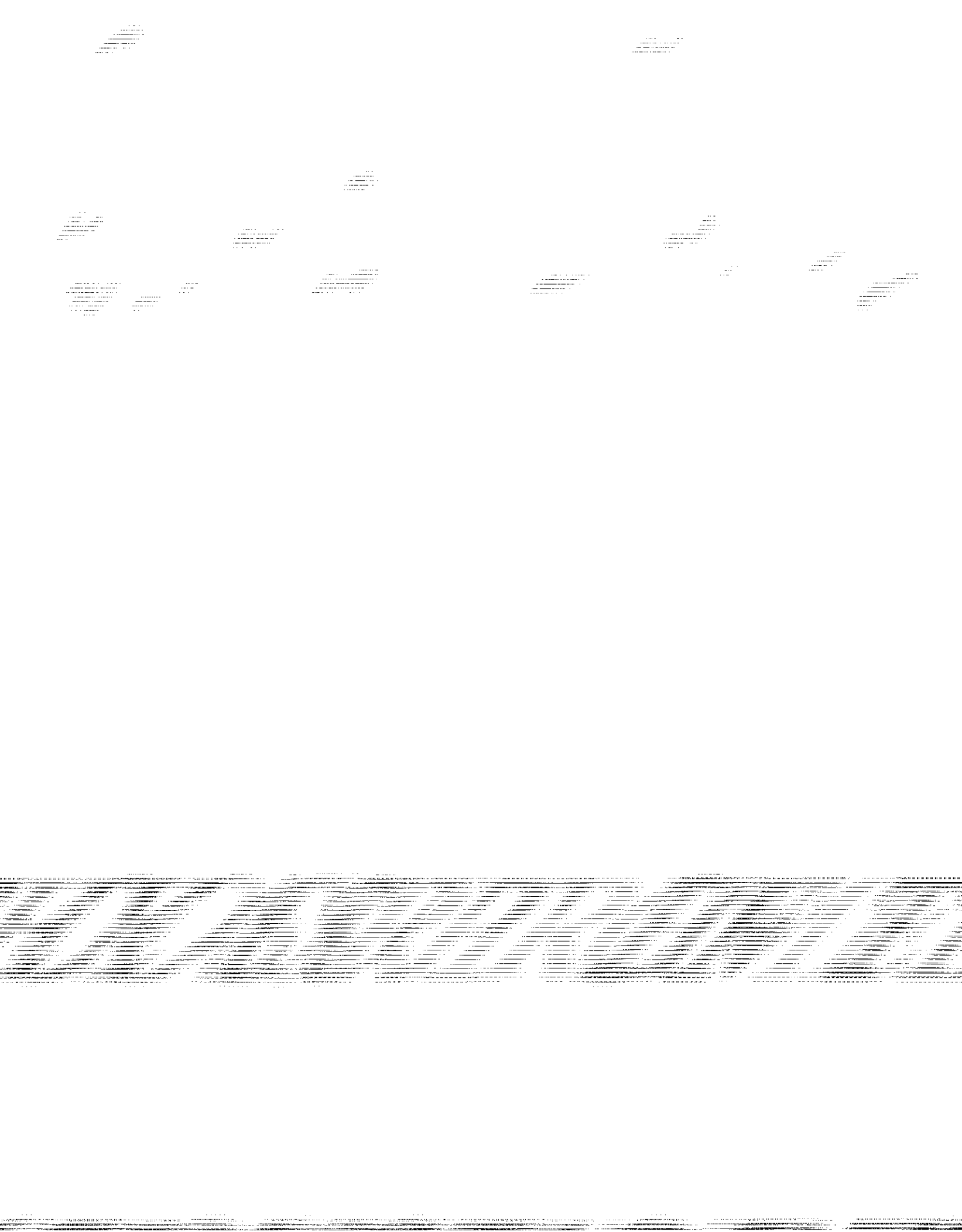


