**II.**

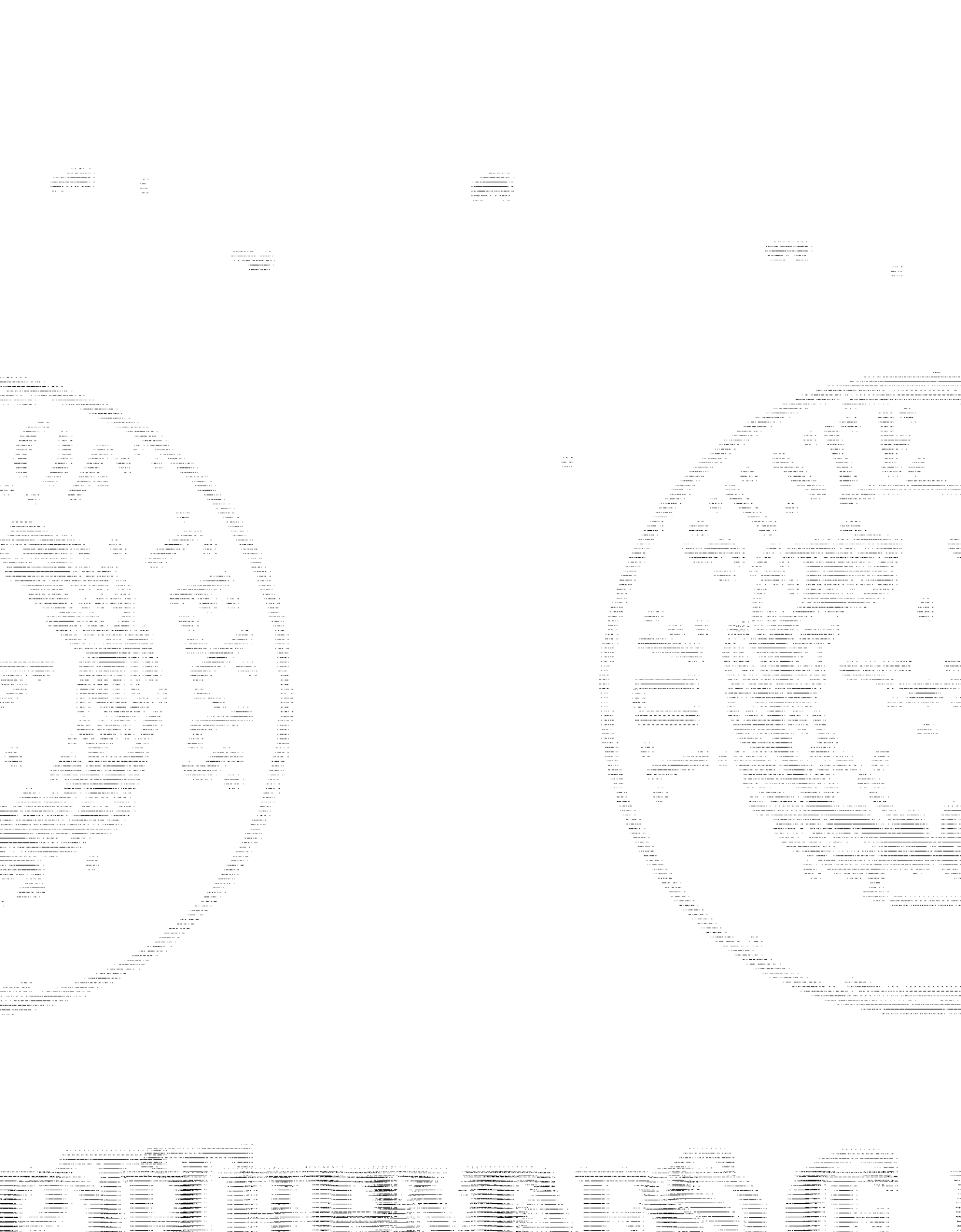
