II.



III.

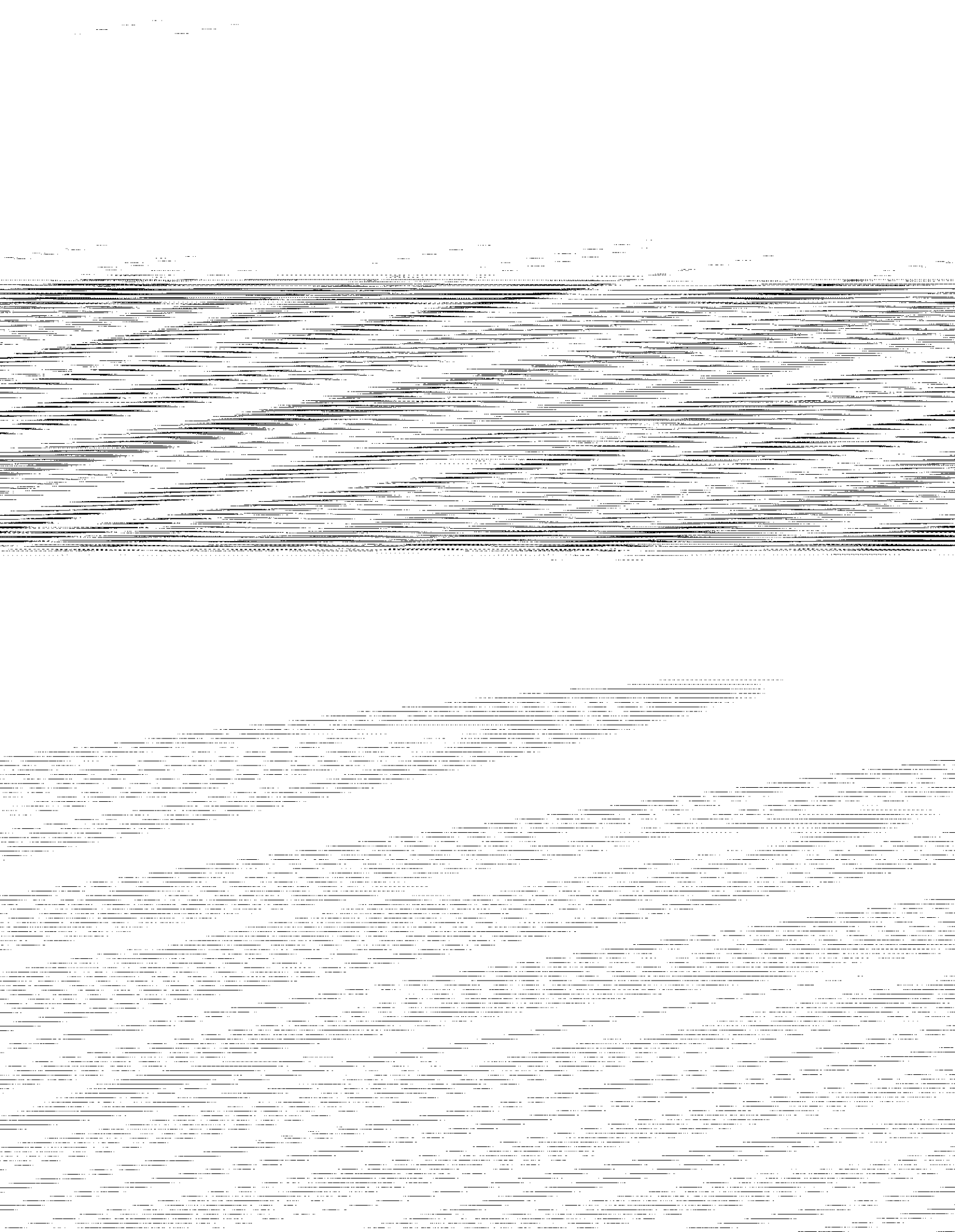
Movant's State Bar Card number is 19793600. Movant's current address is [REDACTED]
