
AMENDED ORDER OF PROMULGATION AND
ADOPTION OF DISCIPLINARY RULES


WHEREAS, this Court has previously promulgated amendments to Parts VII and VIII, the adoption of Part IX, and Rule 7.07 of the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct, as revised by the Court, in its Orders of November 4, 1994 and November 15, 1994 under Miscellaneous Docket Number 94-9167; and of November 28, 1994 under Miscellaneous Docket Number 94-9177.


WHEREAS, the State Bar of Texas and certain parties involved in litigation over these rules have petitioned the Court to extend the effective date of the rules promulgated from April 1, 1995 until 120 days after the date of judgment of the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Texas in the lawsuit styled Texans Against Censorship, Inc., et al, versus State Bar of Texas, et al, which is Cause 3:95 CV 61.

THEREFORE, the Court hereby modifies its Order in this matter dated November 28, 1994, and ORDERS that those rules which are upheld and referenced herein be made effective 120 days after the date of judgment of the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Texas in the lawsuit styled Texans Against Censorship, et al, versus State Bar of Texas, et al.
