

Daniel George Donovan is ordered to return his license and State Bar of Texas membership card (member #05990520) to the Clerk of the Supreme Court of Texas immediately.


It is further ordered that the Director of Membership for the State Bar of Texas note Daniel George Donovan's suspension effective October 31, 1995, on the membership records.




