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
The Court considered the Affidavit of Voluntary Resignation of:







Please refund the \$50.00 membership dues I was required to pay for the year 1999-2000.

I have a very limited practice doing mostly cases for the Volunteer Lawyers for the Poor program out of Cincinnati. I practice from my home doing about two free and six reduced fee cases in the area of family law. Last year I had a business loss. I want to resign from the State bar of Texas as I cannot afford to maintain my membership.

In May I called the Membership Department and asked the gentleman who answered the phone for the proper procedure to resign from the State Bar of Texas. He advised me to send a letter and return my bar card which I did on May 24, 1999.

I received notification from the Membership Department when I returned home from vacation at the end of June that I needed to submit two affidavits and also return my law license. I was also advised that I am now required to pay the membership dues which was due on June 1, 1999. Had I been advised of these additional requirements I would have complied prior to June 1<sup>st</sup> and avoided the \$50.00.

This resignation process is taking over an hour for me to collect the proper information from the Membership Department, draft the affidavits and cover letters and pry the back off the frame to remove my law license. This does not include the trip to the bank for notary services and the trip to the post office and the expense of another certified letter.


