Monday, September 10, 2012 TEXAS BAR CLE TO BEGIN WEBCASTING SUPREME COURT ORAL ARGUMENTS

Under a new partnership Texas Supreme Court oral arguments will be broadcast live beginning Wednesday by the Texas State Bar's continuing legal-education department over the Internet.

TexasBarCLE.com upgraded the recording and encoding process so oral arguments may now be played on "smart" phones or web-enabled tablets, expanding users' viewing options. New search pages available at TexasBarCLE.com will enable viewers more easily to locate and retrieve archived oral-argument videos and accompanying materials.

Web-broadcasting by TexasBarCLE begins at 9 a.m. Wednesday with the Court's oralsubmission docket. The Court has four causes set for argument Wednesday.

Since 2007 the Court's oral arguments and select meetings of Court committees and commissions were broadcast by St. Mary's University School of Law, but St. Mary's terminated its contract with the Court for budget reasons.
