SUMMARY OF REPORTED ACTIVITY FOR YEAR ENDED AUGUST 31, 2001

The Alternative Dispute Resolution centers of Texas were reauthorized and expanded in scope in 1987 by the 70th Legislature "to encourage the peaceable resolution of disputes, with special consideration given to disputes involving the parent-child relationship, ... and the early settlement of pending litigation through voluntary settlement procedures." (Acts 1987, 70th Legislature, Chapter 1121, Section 1.) Alternative Dispute Resolution Centers provide an opportunity to resolve conflicts creatively and effectively outside the courtroom using a variety of mechanisms including mediation, arbitration, negotiation, and moderated settlement conferences.

Ten centers submitted reports for the period of September 1, 2000 through August 31, 2001. Of the activity reported, 17,933 cases were received during the reporting period, 16,601 were closed and 3,161 cases were pending at the end of the reporting period. This summary is based on reports from alternative dispute resolution centers. It does not include information from judges and court clerks, nor from numerous private groups and other organizations, which actively employ alternative dispute resolution procedures that are not reported.
