### COURT OF CRIMINAL APPEALS Analysis Of Activity For Year Ended August 31, 1994

The Court of Criminal Appeals is the highest state court for criminal appeals and is composed of a Presiding Judge and eight judges.


Decisions of the Courts of Appeals in criminal cases may be appealed to the Court of Criminal Appeals by petition for discretionary review, filed either by the State, or the defendant, or both. In addition, the Court may review a decision on its own motion. Appeal of death penalty cases is direct from the trial court to the Court of Criminal Appeals. were cases where discretionary review was granted by the Court and 194 were direct appeals, death penalty appeals, writs of habeas corpus granted, and extraordinary writs. Death penalty appeals in fiscal year 1994 numbered 46, compared to 33 in fiscal year 1993.

The 342 cases added in fiscal year 1994 reresent a decrease of 16.2 percent from the 408 cases added during fiscal year 1993.


### MATTERS ADDED TO THE DOCKET

During the state fiscal year 1994, which ended August 31, 1994, 342 cases were added to the docket of the Court of Criminal Appeals, of which 148 The Court had 1,477 petitions for discretionary review filed during fiscal year 1994, 8.3 percent less than the 1,610 filed during the previous year. Petitions for discretionary review were received from 130 counties,

with 44 percent of them originating from Harris or Dallas Counties. Applications for writs of habeas corpus filed during the year totalled 3,396, a 29.3 percent increase over the 2,627 filed in fiscal year 1993. Also, 1,447 other motions or applications were handled by the Court, a 13.8 percent increase from the 1,271 considered the previous year.

### **RATE OF DISPOSITIONS INCREASES**

During fiscal year 1994, the Court disposed of 216 cases on direct appeal, compared to 286 such dispositions in fiscal year 1993. In 1994, those 216 dispositions represented 65.1 percent of all cases on the docket on direct appeal, that is, cases filed during the year or carried over from previous years. In fiscal year 1993, this disposition rate was 67.5 percent.

In fiscal year 1994, 1,671 petitions for discretionary review were disposed, 148 (or 8.9 percent) of which were granted. The remainder were refused or dismissed. In fiscal year 1993, 1,667 petitions for discretionary review were disposed, 165 (or 10 percent) of which were granted. There were 3,412 applications for writs of habeas corpus disposed in fiscal year 1994, compared to 2,437 in 1993, an increase of 40 percent.

Judges of the Court of Criminal Appeals wrote 468 opinions during fiscal year 1994, of which 342 (73 percent) were "deciding" opinions disposing of cases. The remainder were dissents, concurrences, and opinions on rehearings. Of the deciding opinions, 156 were signed and 186 were per curiam. During 1993, members of the Court wrote 679 opinions, 76 percent of which were deciding opinions.

### TOTAL PENDING CASELOAD DECREASES

On August 31, 1994, 1,338 total matters (excluding miscellaneous motions and applications) were pending in the Court of Criminal Appeals. This represented a decrease of 13.6 percent from the 1,549 matters pending on August 31, 1993.

Of these 1,338 matters, 124 were direct appeals, death penalty appeals, granted habeas corpus writs, and extraordinary writs, 115 were granted discretionary review cases, 407 were petitions for discretionary review, and 692 were applications for writs of habeas corpus.
