

ORDER CREATING ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON JUDICIAL EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS AND COURT SECURITY

ORDERED that:

1. In response to the recommendations of the Supreme Court Task Force on Emergency Preparedness and in furtherance of the judicial branch's interest in promoting the security of judges both in and away from their courthouses, the Supreme Court of Texas hereby establishes an ongoing Advisory Committee on Judicial Emergency Preparedness and Court Security.
2. The Advisory Committee shall be selected by and supported by staff from the Office of Court Administration.
3. The Office of Court Administration's Court Security Director must report to the Court annually on issues of court security and emergency preparedness, with the first annual report to be delivered by December 1, 2018.
4. Justice Jeffrey S. Boyd will serve as the Court's liaison to the advisory committee.


