**Evidence Description, Results of Analysis and Interpretation:**

**01: ligature removed from Maria Murphy's hands**

This item was swabbed for potential DNA.

**01-01 swabbing from ligature**

This item was retained.

**02: bedding removed from washing machine**

No stains having the appearance of semen were observed on this item.

Trace evidence was collected. The collected trace evidence has been packaged with the evidence. No further trace analysis was conducted at this time.

**03: light grey hooded sweatshirt with red-brown staining**

A presumptive test for the presence of blood was negative.

Three stains having the appearance of semen were observed.

**03-01: cuttings of three stains having the appearance of semen**

These stains were collected and retained.

**04: Sexual Assault Kit (Maria Murphy)**

**04-01: vaginal swabs**

Semen was detected on this item.

This item was retained.

**04-02: rectal swabs**

This item was not examined.

**04-03: oral swabs**

This item was not examined.

**04-04: breast swabs**

This item was not examined.

**04-05: fingernail swabs**

**04-05-AA: right hand fingernail swabs**

This item was retained.

**04-05-AB: left hand fingernail swabs**
