Fourth Court of Appeals to Hear Oral Argument

The Fourth Court of Appeals will hear oral arguments in one appeal on Friday, March 7, 2025, beginning at 10:00 a.m., before the following panel of justices: Justice Lori Massey Brissette, Justice Adrian A. Spears II, and Justice H. Todd McCray.

The following case will be presented:

In the Interest of A.C.P., et al., Children. Appellant challenges both the trial court's termination of her parental rights to five children and the trial court's order naming the Department of Family and Protective Services as the children's managing conservator. This appeal concerns the legal and factual sufficiency of the evidence supporting (1) the predicate grounds for the trial court's termination of appellant's parental rights, (2) the trial court's best interest findings, and (3) the trial court's conservatorship determination.
