DISQUALIFICATIONS FOR GRAND JURY SERVICE

(Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, Art. 19A.101)

If you are Disqualified: Mark the disqualification(s) that apply to you. Sign the form.

Mail or take the form to the <county> district clerk's office.

NOTE: You *must* report all juror disqualifications that apply to you.

You are disqualified and may not serve as a grand juror if:

1. ☐ You are less than 18 years of age.
2. ☐ You are not a citizen of the United States. (*Note: If you state that you are not a U.S. citizen, you will no longer be eligible to vote if you fail to provide proof of U.S. citizenship to your county voter registrar.*)
3. ☐ You are not a resident of <summoning county> County, Texas, where you are summoned to serve as a juror or any of the contiguous counties, identified as <names of contiguous counties>. (*Note: If you claim to be disqualified because you are not a resident of <county> county, you may become ineligible to vote in that county.*)
4. ☐ You are not qualified under the Constitution and laws to vote in <county> County or in or any of the contiguous counties, identified as <name(s) of contiguous counties>. (*Note: You do not have to be registered to vote to be qualified to vote.*)
5. ☐ You are not of sound mind and good moral character.
6. ☐ You are not able to read and write.
7. ☐ You have ever been convicted of misdemeanor theft.
8. ☐ You have ever been convicted of a felony.
9. ☐ You are under indictment or other legal accusation for misdemeanor theft or a felony.
10. ☐ You are related within the third degree of consanguinity or second degree of affinity, as determined under Chapter 573, Government Code, to any person selected to serve or serving on the same grand jury.
11. ☐ You have served as a grand juror in the year before the date on which the term of court for which you are summoned to serve as a grand juror begins.
12. ☐ You are a complainant in any matter to be heard by the grand jury during the term of court for which you are to serve as a grand juror.

EXEMPTIONS FROM GRAND JURY SERVICE

(Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, Article 19A.105)

To request an Exemption: Mark the exemption(s) that apply to you. Sign the form.

Mail or take the form to the <county> district clerk's office.

NOTE: You do not have to claim an exemption and may instead choose to serve.

1. ☐ You are 75 years of age or older.
2. ☐ You are responsible for the care of a child younger than 18 years of age and the child will be without adequate supervision if you serve on the grand jury.
3. ☐ You are a student at a public or private high school.
4. ☐ You are enrolled and in actual attendance at an institution of higher education.

Note: The court may also excuse you for any other reason the court determines is reasonable.

Right to Reemployment: An employer may not discharge, threaten to discharge, intimidate, or coerce any permanent employee because the employee serves as a juror, or for the employee's attendance or scheduled attendance in connection with the service, in any court in the United States. (Civil Practice and Remedies Code, Section 122.001)

Failure to Attend Grand Jury Service: Absent a reasonable excuse, a person may be fined not less than \$100 nor more than \$500 if the person fails to attend court as required by this summons. (Code of Criminal Procedure, Article 19A.054)
