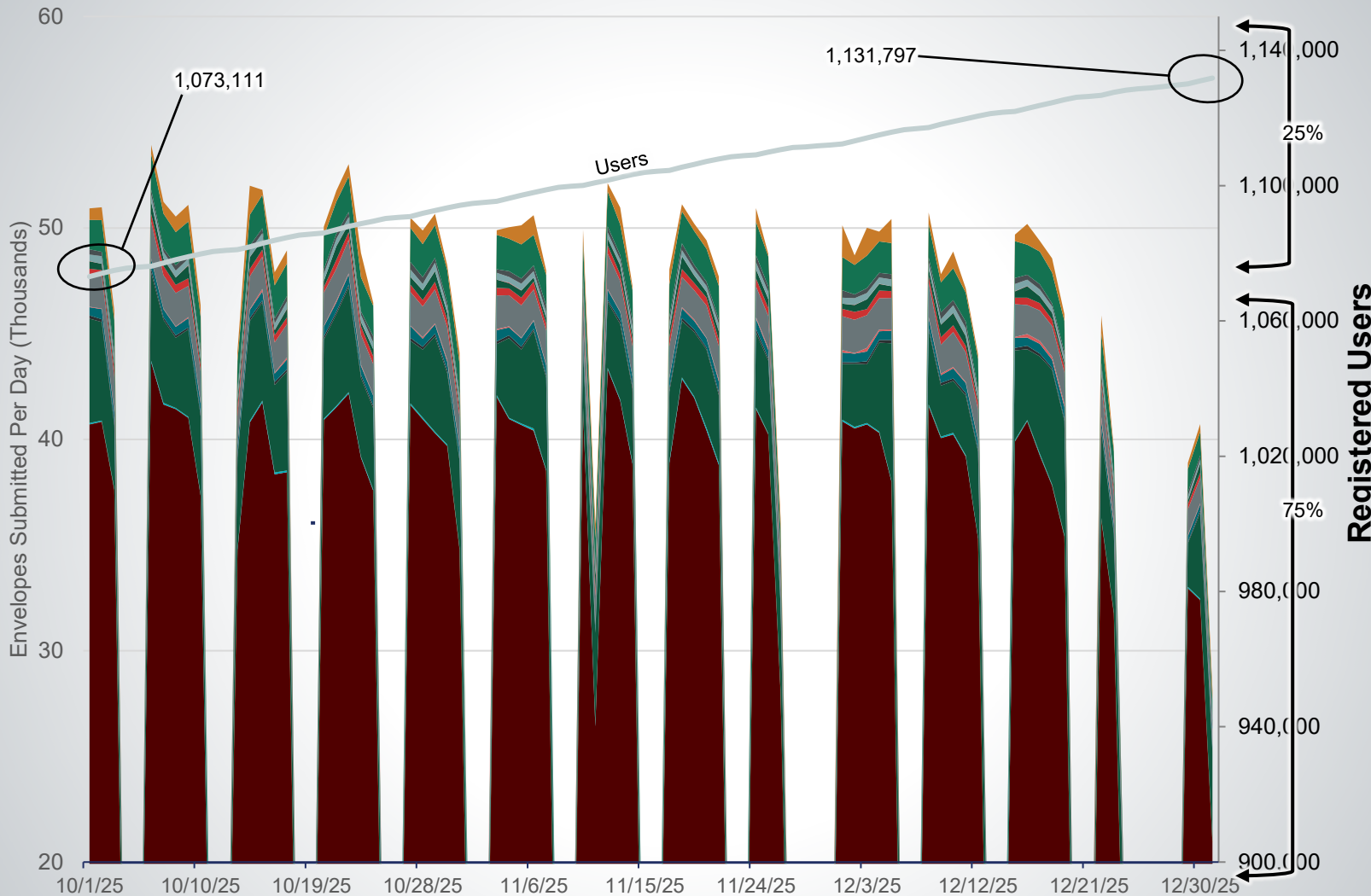

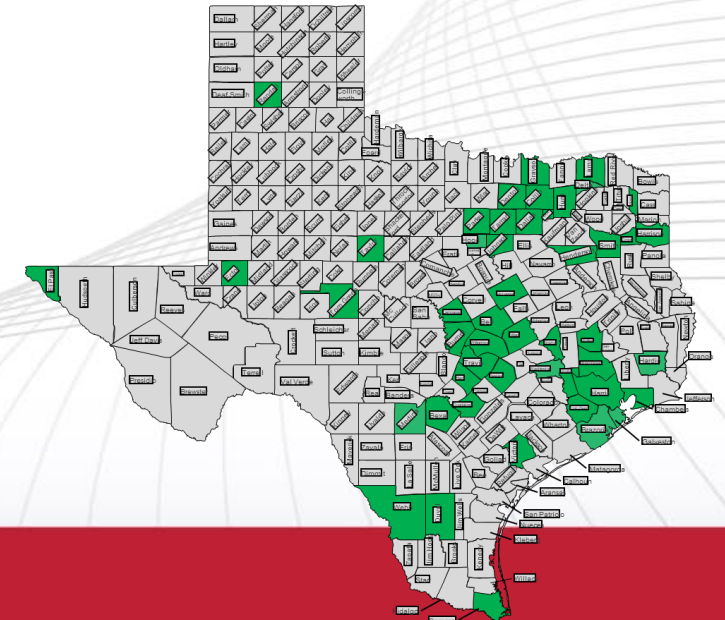


Program Continues to Thrive

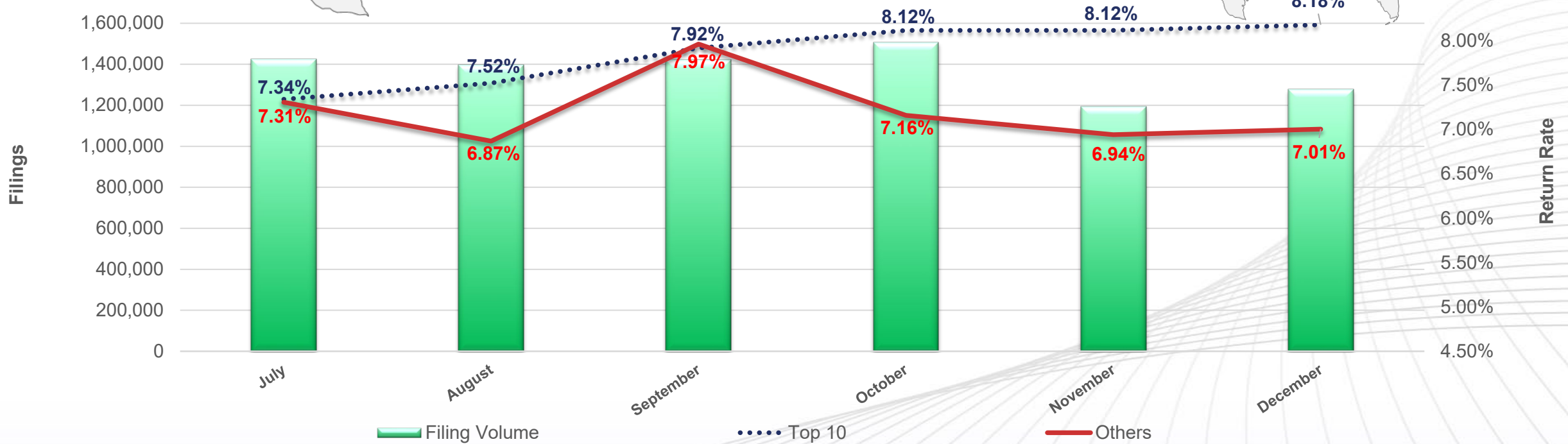
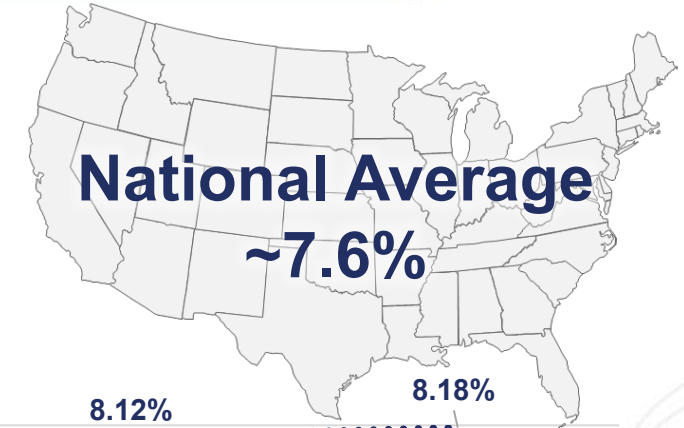
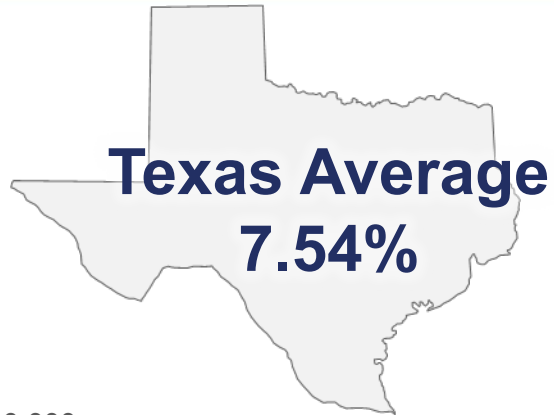
- Over 1 million user accounts created to-date

- 9 active/pending JP engagements



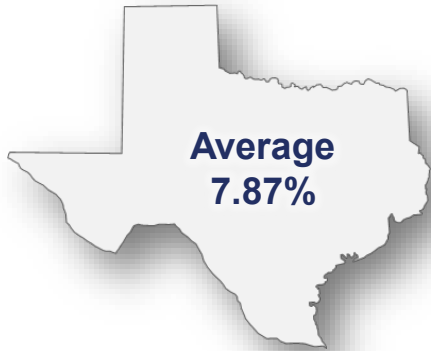
Return for Correction Rates – Market Comparison

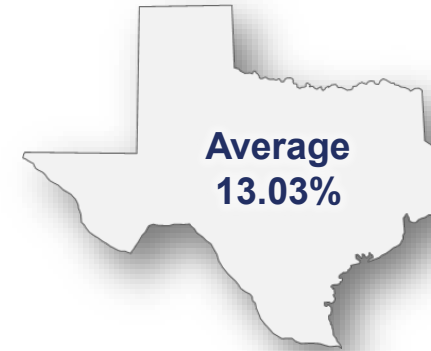

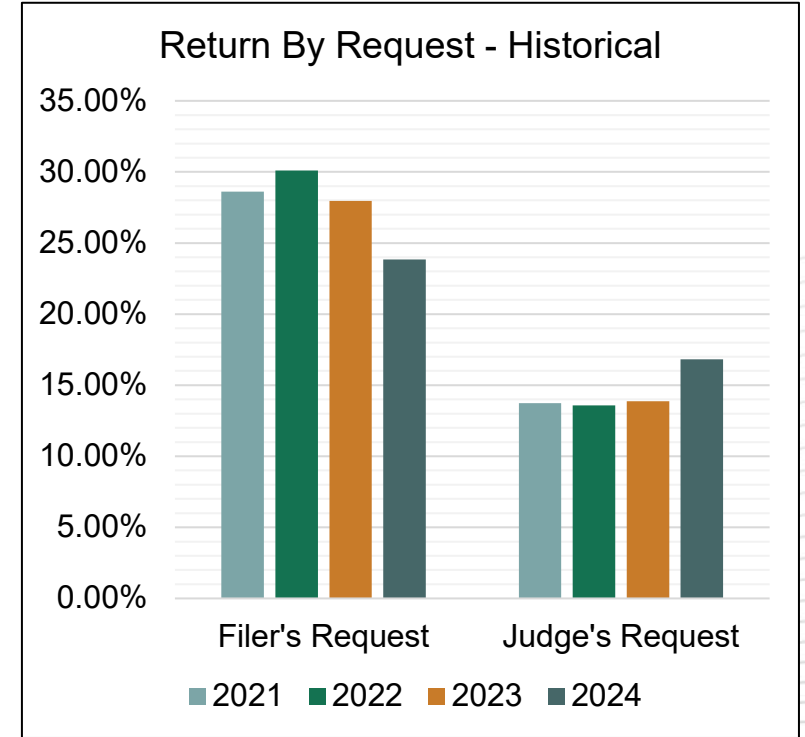
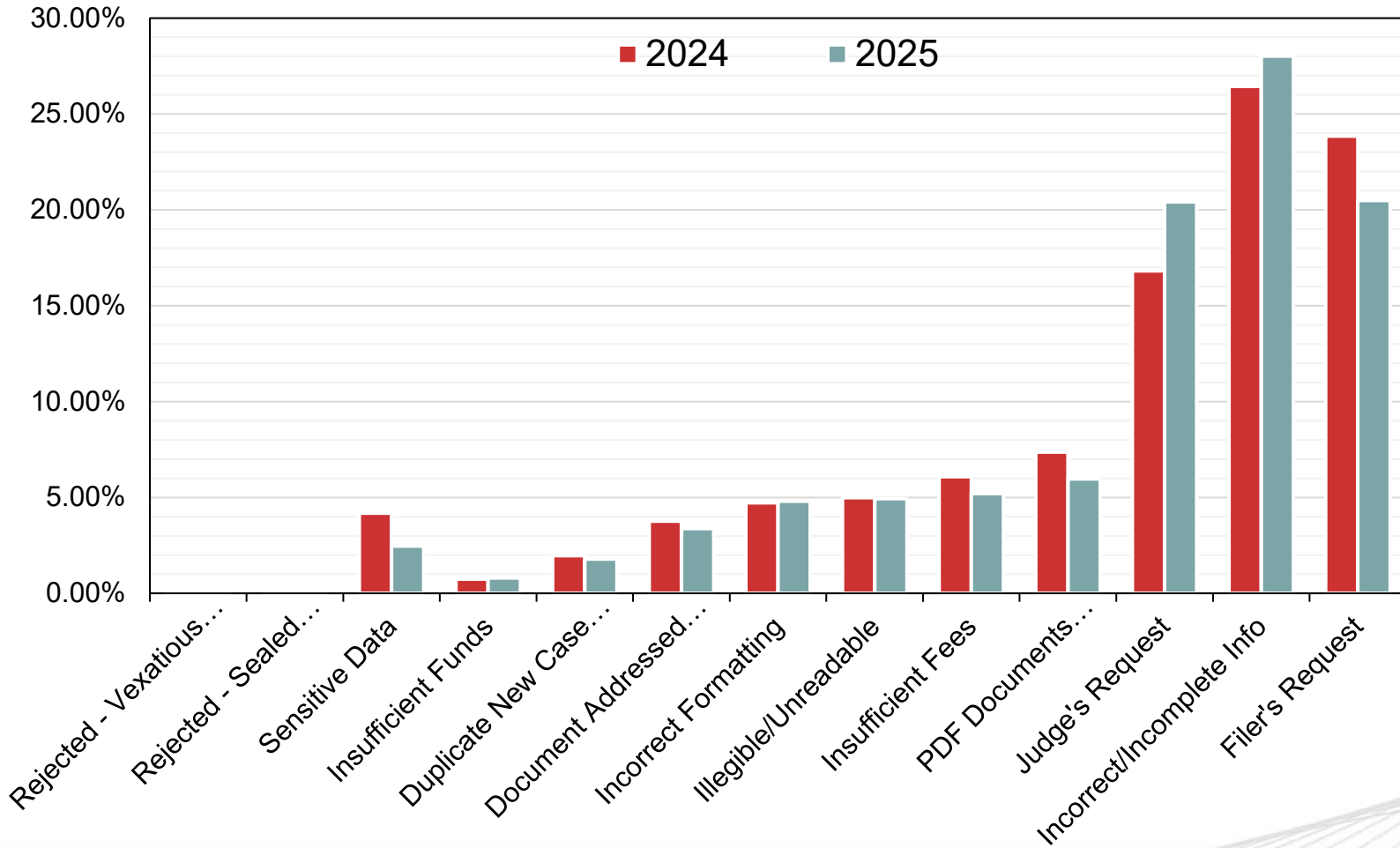

Return for Correction Rates by Return Reason

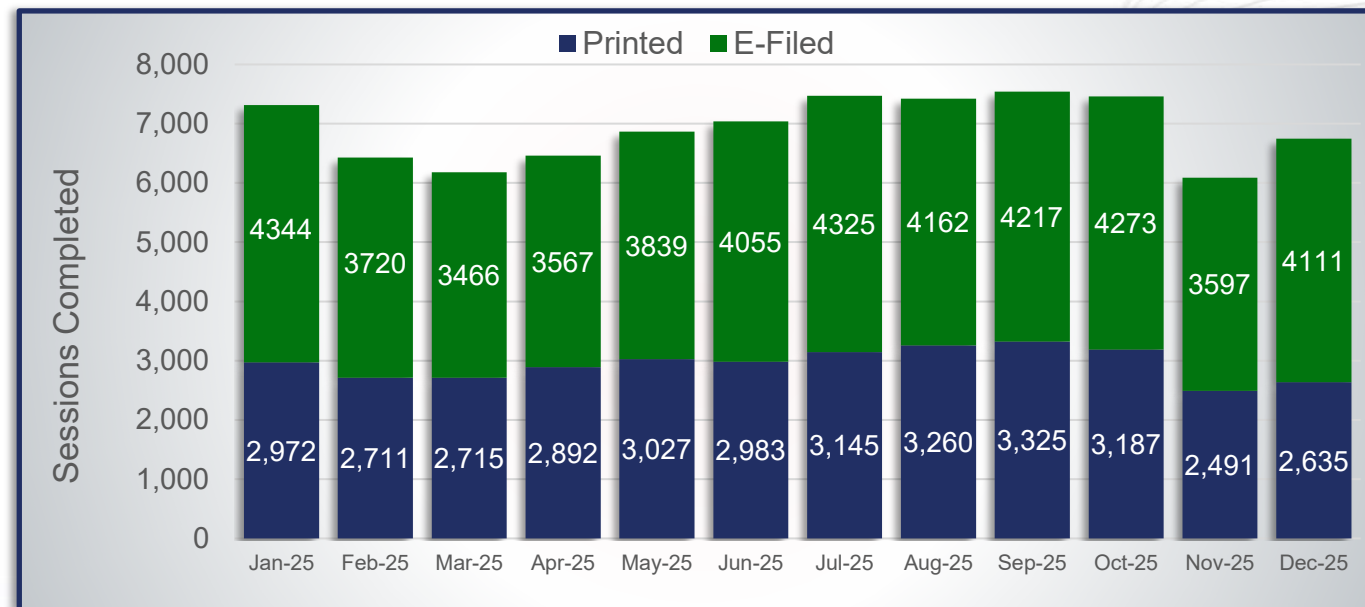
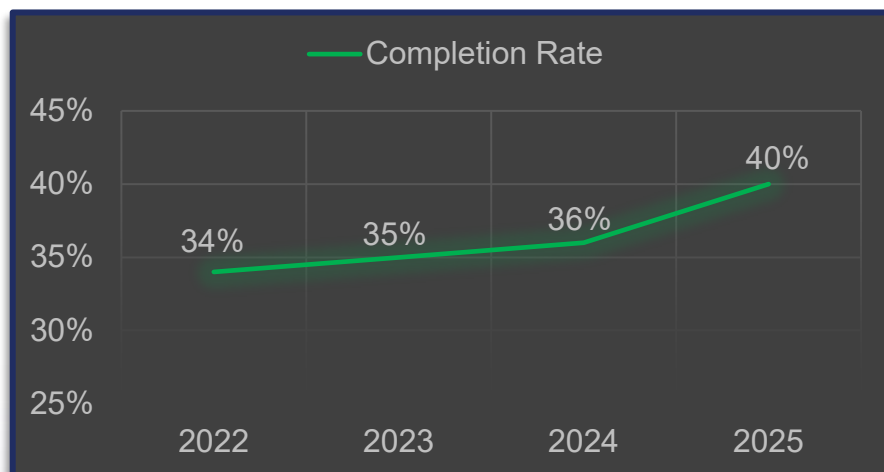


Summary

- **eFileTexas Self Help average completion rate continues to improve**

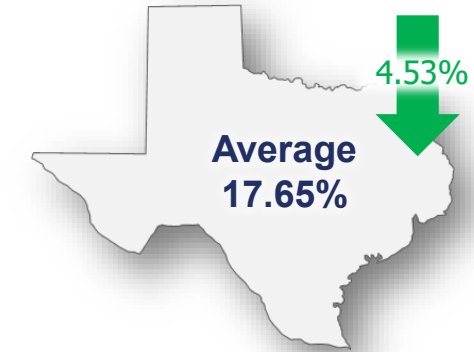
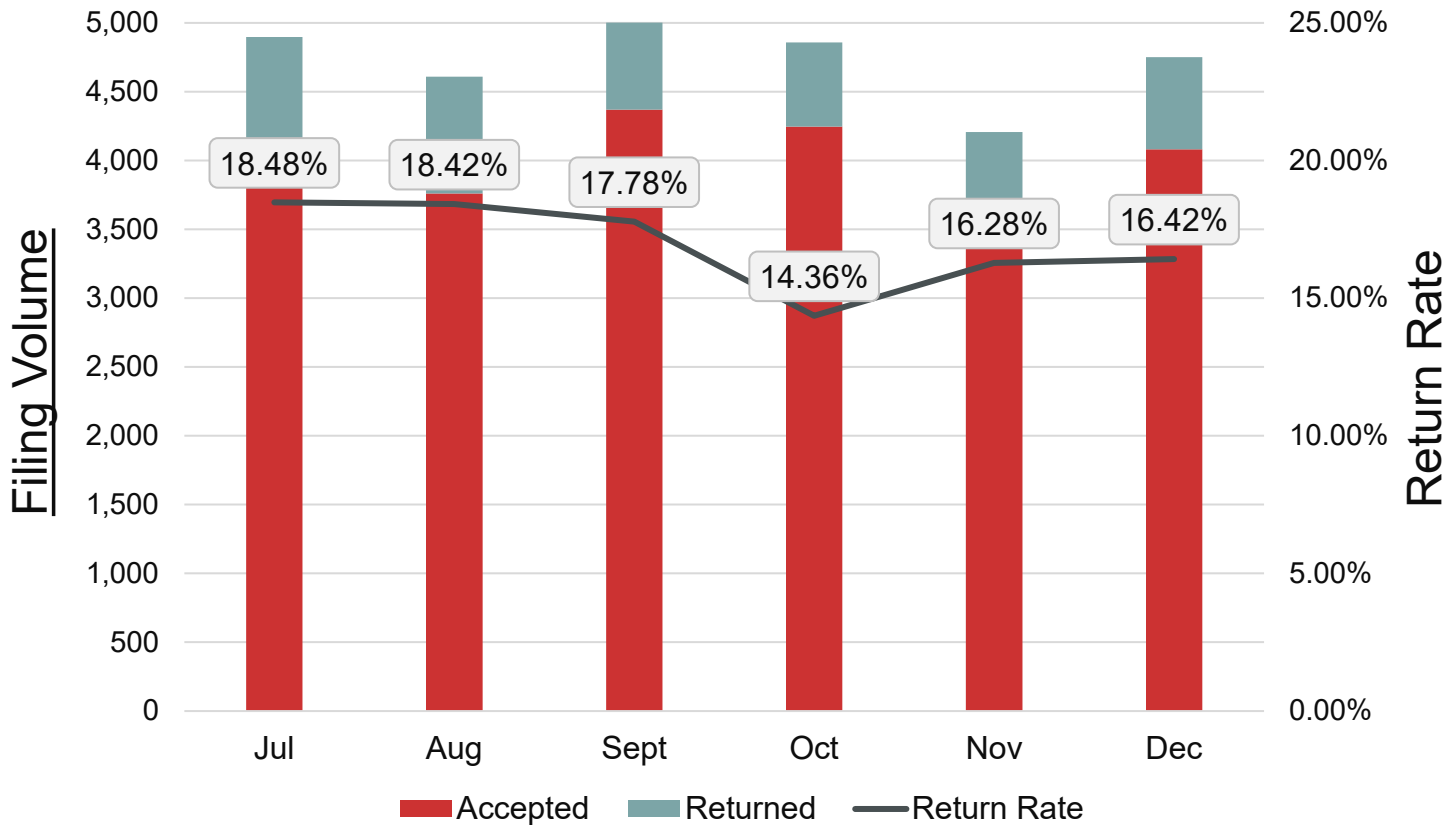

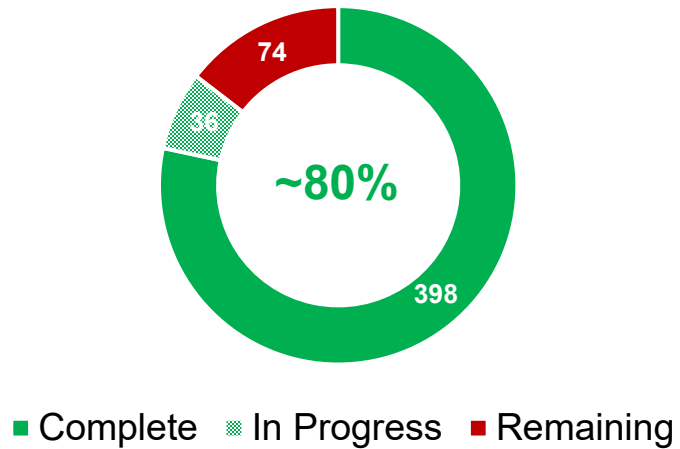

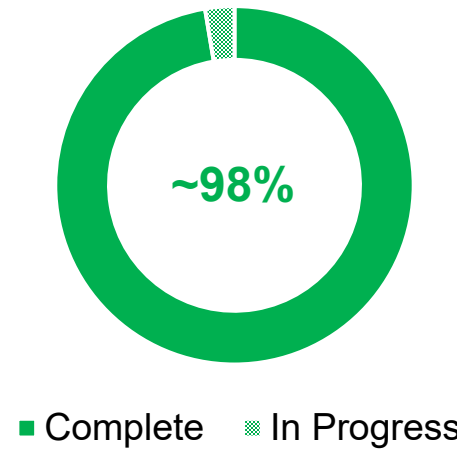

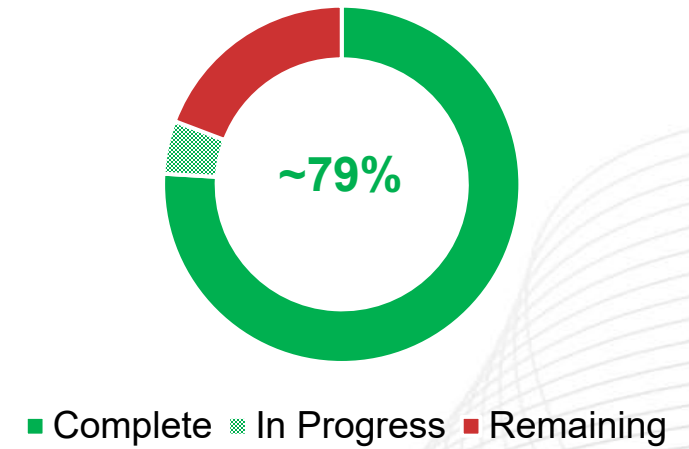
Statewide Integration Status

Flight 3 – Summary:

- **Austin County** – focused on their SaaS move this month (complete). This will truncate timeline to implement re:SearchTX integration.
- **Kerr County** – Significant CMS configuration required to support re:SearchTX integration and differentiating in case/document security levels to align with JCIT standard policies.
- **iDocket** – continuing to work with their counties on integration testing
- **i3Verticals (NetData)** – Live with 5 additional counties as of 1/9/26. Currently developing towards batch integration model.
- **eDoc** - Currently developing towards batch integration model. Piloting with Coryell County.

ReSearchTX Criminal Pilots – Denton and Bexar Counties



Scope: Enable criminal metadata for criminal case types, and display documents for 5 events, per JCIT standards

Status: Both counties are closing out testing but have encountered issue with displaying specific documents.

Issue Description: reSearchTX's security logic cannot *programmatically* limit displaying documents on specific event types.

Recommendations:

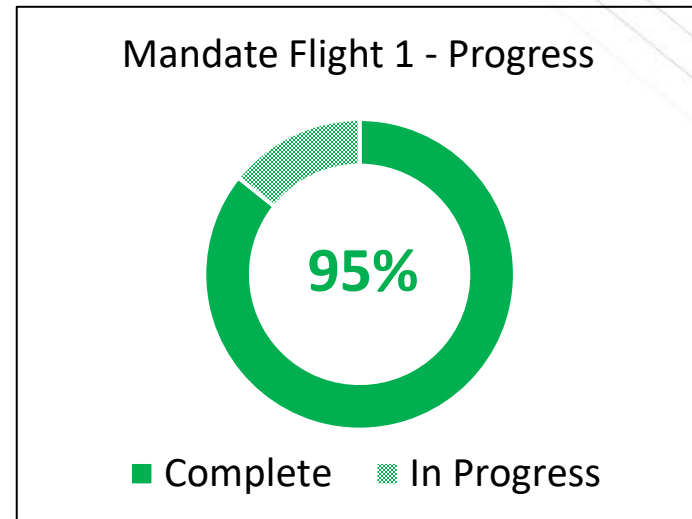
1. Update JCIT Standards policy to allow courts to display CR documents that have a **public** security
2. Do not allow the display of *any* documents associated to CR cases until JCIT Standards policy incorporates remaining CR document/event types

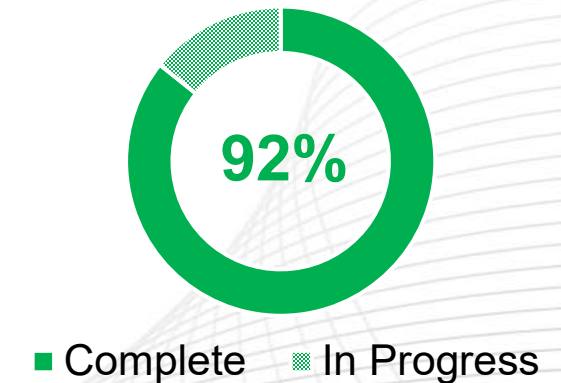

Final Approval of Amendments to Texas Rules of Civil Procedure 21, 165a, 239a, 246, 297, 298, 299, 299a, and 306a; Texas Rule of Appellate Procedure 9.2; and Rule 2.7 of the Statewide Rules Governing Electronic Filing in Criminal Cases

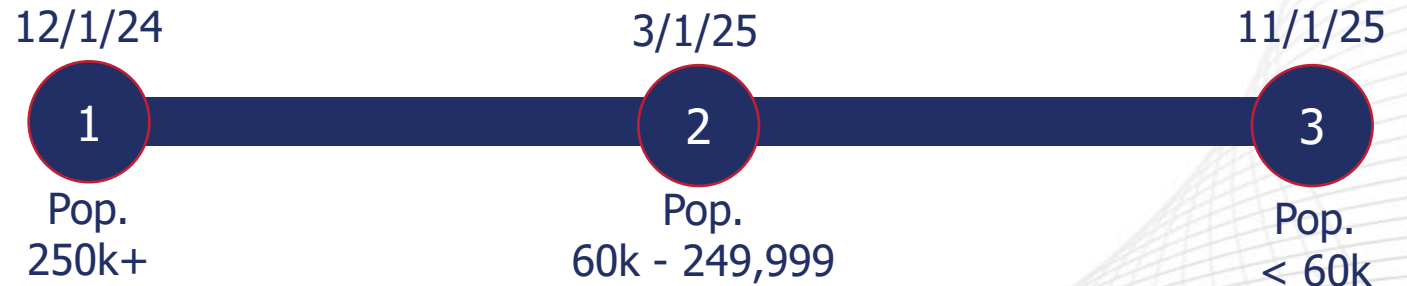
ORDERED that:

1. On September 8, 2023, in Misc. Dkt. No. 23-9071, the Court preliminarily approved amendments to Texas Rules of Civil Procedure 21, 165a, 239a, 246, 297, 298, 299, 299a, and 306a; Texas Rule of Appellate Procedure 9.2; and Rule 2.7 of the Statewide Rules Governing Electronic Filing in Criminal Cases, effective immediately. The Court invited public comment and directed the Judicial Committee on Information Technology ("JCIT") to study and make recommendations on copying court orders, notices, and other documents in civil cases to re:SearchTX.
2. The comment period expired on January 1, 2024. JCIT submitted its recommendations on March 5, 2024. Those recommendations are attached as Exhibit 1 to this Order.
3. Following the comment period and the receipt of JCIT's recommendations, the Court made revisions to the rules. Those revisions are shown in redline. This Order incorporates the revisions and contains the final version of the amended rules, effective immediately.
4. This Order also mandates district and county clerks to integrate their local case management systems with re:SearchTX. Integration will be mandatory according to the following implementation schedule based on the counties' 2020 Federal Census population:
 - a. Courts in counties with a population of 250,000 or more – October 1, 2024;
 - b. Courts in counties with a population of 60,000 to 249,999 – March 1, 2025;
 - c. Courts in counties with a population less than 60,000 – November 1, 2025.

re:SearchTX Integration Mandate

- Requires all counties to be integrated with civil case types
- Criminal case types can be included, but are optional
- Recently updated to reflect 12/1/24 mandate date for phase 1

Free Case Alerts

- Attorney of Record and Parties can now receive free case alerts on their cases
- Attorney and Parties may opt out of all case alerts, or on a case-by-case basis
