ORDER DECLARING VEXATIOUS LITIGANT

On this day, the Court considered Defendant Chassidy Davis's Motion to Declare Plaintiff a Vexatious Litigant. After considering the motion, pleadings, evidence, arguments of the parties, and applicable law, the Court finds that the motion should be **GRANTED**.

The Court finds that Plaintiff Weslee Joel Bolton is a vexatious litigant under Chapter 11 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code. The Court further finds that there is not a reasonable probability that Mr. Bolton will prevail in this litigation against Ms. Davis.

The Court further finds that Mr. Bolton has commenced, prosecuted, or maintained at least five litigations pro se in the seven-year period preceding the filing of Defendant's motion that were finally determined adversely to him, permitted to remain pending at least two years without trial or hearing, or determined to be frivolous or groundless.

The Court further finds that Mr. Bolton has attempted pro se to relitigate claims, controversies, and issues previously determined against him and involving Defendant Chassidy Jean Davis.

It is therefore **ORDERED** that Plaintiff **Weslee Joel Bolton** is declared a vexatious litigant under Chapter 11 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code.

It is further **ORDERED** that Plaintiff **Weslee Joel Bolton** is prohibited from filing pro se any new litigation in a Texas court without first obtaining permission from the appropriate local administrative judge as required by Chapter 11 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code.
