Detailed Description of Offenses in each Misdemeanor Category

- A Passing School Bus Offense (Transportation Code, § 545.066)
- B Rules of the Road Offense¹ (other than a Parking Offense, Pedestrian Offense, or Passing School Bus Offense) that is a moving violation²
- C Rules of the Road Offense (other than a Parking Offense, Pedestrian Offense, or Passing School Bus Offense) that is not a moving violation)
- D School Non-attendance offense (Education Code, §§ 25.093, 25.094)
- E General fine-only misdemeanor offense³ that is a moving violation
- F General fine-only misdemeanor offense that is not a moving violation
- G State Parking Offense or State Pedestrian Offense that is a Rules of the Road Offense
- H State Parking Offense or State Pedestrian Offense that is not a Rules of the Road Offense
- I Violation of Municipal Parking Ordinance
- J Violation of Municipal Pedestrian Ordinance

¹A rules-of-the-road offense is any offense found in Transportation Code, Chapters 541 – 600.
